### Description

The Bachelor course in Acupuncture deals with Chinese medical art for treating practised for over 5000 years. It is a non-invasive treatment that involves inserting needles into specific places on the body's surface to activate physiological processes. Applying pressure to these places can help the body's healing process. The foundation of this technique is the belief that our bodies have a continual flow of energy known as chi. A meridian is a path along which this energy flows. The flow of chi is thought to be interrupted and out of balance when we suffer from sickness. As a result, acupuncture tries to eliminate chi disruptions and restore a balanced flow of energy throughout the body by applying pressure to the appropriate places. Acupuncture is a type of therapy that involves direct contact with the patient.
